Section 321.445, subsection 4, paragraph b, 2 subparagraph (2), Code 2003, is amended to read as follows: 3 (2) If the evidence supports such a finding, the trier of 4 fact may find that the plaintiff's failure to wear a safety 5 belt or safety harness in violation of this section 6 contributed to the plaintiff's claimed injury or injuries, and 7 may reduce the amount of plaintiff's recovery by an amount not 8 to exceed five percent of the damages awarded proportionate to 9 the degree to which the failure to wear a safety belt or 10 safety harness contributed to the plaintiff's claimed injury

1 11 or injuries, after any reductions for comparative fault. 1 12 EXPLANATION This bill eliminates the limitation on the reduction in 1 13 1 14 damages awarded to plaintiffs who fail to wear a safety belt

1 15 or safety harness. Currently, Code section 321.445 provides 1 16 that the trier of fact may reduce the amount of a plaintiff's 1 17 recovery by an amount not to exceed 5 percent of the damages 1 18 awarded after any reductions for comparative fault if the 19 evidence supports a finding that the plaintiff's failure to 1 20 wear the belt or harness, in violation of that section, 1 21 contributed to the plaintiff's claimed injury or injuries. 22 LSB 1786HC 80
