Section 1. $\underline{\text{NEW SECTION}}$. 677.10A PREJUDGMENT INTEREST. If any offer to confess judgment is made under this chapter 1 3 and is not accepted, and a subsequent trial results in a 4 judgment which is less than the offer to confess judgment, 5 prejudgment interest shall not be calculated or be subject to 6 recovery after the date of the offer to confess judgment. EXPLANATION

This bill limits recovery of prejudgment interest in any 1 9 pending or proposed action where an offer to confess judgment 1 10 is made, but is not accepted, and a subsequent trial results 1 11 in a judgment that is less than the amount in the offer to 1 12 confess judgment. In such a case, no prejudgment interest is 1 13 to be calculated or is recoverable after the date of the offer 1 14 to confess judgment. 1 15 LSB 1781HC 80
