Section 1. Section 455E.11, subsection 2, paragraph b, 2 subparagraph (3), subparagraph subdivision (a), Code
3 Supplement 2003, is amended to read as follows:
4 (a) Thirty=five Thirty=four and one-half percent is 1

5 appropriated annually for the Leopold center for sustainable 6 agriculture at Iowa state university of science and technology.

Section 455E.11, subsection 2, paragraph b, Sec. 2. 9 subparagraph (3), subparagraph subdivision (b), unnumbered 10 paragraph 1, Code Supplement 2003, is amended to read as 1 11 follows:

Two and one=half percent is appropriated annually to the 1 13 department and, except for administrative expenses, is 1 14 transferred to the Iowa department of public health for the 1 15 purpose of administering grants to counties and conducting 1 16 oversight of county=based programs for the testing of private 1 17 rural water supply wells, private rural water supply well 1 18 sealing, and the proper closure of private rural abandoned 1 19 wells and cisterns. Not more than thirty=five percent of the 20 moneys is appropriated annually for grants to counties for the 21 purpose of conducting programs of private rural water supply 1 22 testing, private rural water supply well sealing, the proper 23 closure of private rural abandoned wells and cisterns, or any 1 24 combination thereof. An amount agreed to by the department of 1 25 natural resources and the Iowa department of public health 26 shall be retained by the department of natural resources for 27 administrative expenses.

EXPLANATION

This bill amends Code chapter 455E, which provides 30 policies, programs, and expenditures for groundwater 31 protection, including by creating the groundwater protection 32 fund in Code section 455E.11. The fund includes various 33 accounts. One account is the agricultural management account, 34 which is supported in part by fees collected under Code 35 chapter 200 regulating fertilizers and soil conditioners and 1 Code chapter 206 regulating pesticides. After initial moneys 2 are appropriated, the remaining amount is allocated according 3 to a formula. The first 35 percent is appropriated to the 4 Leopold center for sustainable agriculture at Iowa state 5 university of science and technology. The next 2 percent is 6 appropriated to the department of natural resources, which, 7 after taking an amount for administrative expenses, transfers 8 the moneys to the Iowa department of public health for the 9 purpose of administering grants to counties. The grants as The grants are 10 to be used for the testing of private rural water supply 11 wells, private rural water supply well sealing, and the proper 12 closure of private rural abandoned wells and cisterns.

The bill reduces the appropriation made to the Leopold 2 14 center by one=half percent and increases the appropriation 15 made to support the grants to counties by the same amount.
