- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 8.60A RESTORATION OF DESIGNATED 2 MONEYS USED FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
- 3 1. State fees that are received during a fiscal year
- 4 beginning on or after July 1, 2003, that are deposited into a
- 5 specific account or fund to be used for a specific purpose
- 6 shall not be transferred or appropriated from that account or
- 7 fund for purposes other than the specified purpose, except as
- 8 provided in subsection 2.
- 9 2. The Act that transfers or appropriates dedicated moneys
- 10 as described in subsection 1 shall contain a provision that
- 11 provides for the restoring of the transferred or appropriated
- 12 moneys over a period not to exceed five fiscal years with at
- 13 least twenty percent being restored in any fiscal year. The
- 14 period for the restoration shall begin with the first fiscal
- 15 year following the fiscal year for which the transfer or
- 16 appropriation is made.
- 17 3. The funds to which subsection 1 apply include, but are
- 18 not limited to the following:
- 19 a. Title quaranty fund created in section 16.91.
- 20 b. Special conservation fund created in section 321G.7.
- 21 c. Waste tire management fund created in section 455D.11C.
- d. Groundwater protection fund created in section 455E.ll.
- 23 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of
- 24 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 25 EXPLANATION
- 26 This bill provides that when fees which are dedicated for a
- 27 specific purpose are transferred or appropriated from a
- 28 specific account or fund for another purpose, those fees are
- 29 to be restored. The restoration would be made to the account
- 30 or fund over a period not to exceed five fiscal years with at
- 31 least 20 percent restored in each fiscal year. The
- 32 restoration schedule would be contained in the same Act in
- 33 which the transfer or appropriation is made.
- 34 The bill identifies four funds to which this requirement
- 35 specifically applies. These are the title guaranty fund,
