Notwithstanding section 17A.2, subsection 11, paragraph "g", the department of natural resources shall adopt administrative rules establishing a-range-of prices of plant material grown at the state forest nurseries to-cover that will result in reimbursing the department for all expenses related to the growing of the plants plus a twenty-five percent margin.

10 Sec. 2. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 481A.79 STATE FISH NURSERIES AND 11 HATCHERIES.

Notwithstanding section 17A.2, subsection 11, paragraph "g", the department of natural resources shall adopt administrative rules establishing prices of fish stock hatched and grown at the state fish nurseries and hatcheries that will result in reimbursing the department for all expenses related to the hatching and growing of the fish plus a twenty-five percent margin.

This bill provides that the department of natural resources shall adopt administrative rules that establish prices for the sale of plant material from state forest nurseries and fish stock from state fish nurseries and hatcheries that result in reimbursing the department for all expenses related to the frowing of the plants or fish plus a 25 percent margin.
