                             EXPLANATION
      This bill abolishes the targeted small business financial
 9 assistance program and makes conforming amendments.
10 program provides financial assistance to targeted small
11 businesses which are defined as businesses which are 51
12 percent or more owned, operated, and actively managed by one
13 or more women, minority persons, or persons with a disability
14 provided the businesses are located in this state, are
15 operated for profit, and have an annual gross income of less
16 than $3 million computed as an average of the three preceding
17 fiscal years.
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
