- 1 Section 1. Section 217.30, subsection 2, Code 2003, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 2. a. Information described in subsection 1 shall not be
- 4 disclosed to or used by any person or agency except for
- 5 purposes of administration of the programs of services or
- 6 assistance, and shall not in any case, except as otherwise
- 7 provided in this subsection or subsection 4, paragraph "b", be
- 8 disclosed to or used by persons or agencies outside the
- 9 department unless they are subject to standards of
- 10 confidentiality comparable to those imposed on the department
- ll by this division.
- b. If the department has information described in
- 13 subsection 1 that a person living in the home of a client of
- 14 the department has committed a sexual offense, the department
- 15 may disclose that information to the adult persons living in
- 16 that home. For the purpose of this paragraph, "committed a
- 17 sexual offense" means the person is required to register with
- 18 the sex offender registry in accordance with chapter 692A, or
- 19 is listed in the child or dependent adult abuse registry as
- 20 having been found to have committed abuse that was sexual in
- 21 nature.
- Sec. 2. Section 235A.15, Code 2003, is amended by adding
- 23 the following new subsection:
- 24 NEW SUBSECTION. 10. The department may disclose child
- 25 abuse information to adult persons living in the home of a
- 26 client of the department, for purposes of providing
- 27 information in accordance with section 217.30, subsection 2,
- 28 paragraph "b", that a person living in that home has committed
- 29 a sexual offense.
- 30 Sec. 3. Section 235B.6, subsection 2, paragraph e, Code
- 31 2003, is amended by adding the following new subparagraph:
- 32 NEW SUBPARAGRAPH. (10) To adult persons living in the
- 33 home of a client of the department, for purposes of providing
- 34 information in accordance with section 217.30, subsection 2,
- 35 paragraph "b", that a person living in that home has committed

l a sexual offense.

- 2 Sec. 4. Section 692A.13, Code 2003, is amended by adding 3 the following new subsection:
- 4 NEW SUBSECTION. 9. The department of human services may
- 5 disclose information to adult persons living in the home of a
- 6 client of the department of human services, for purposes of
- 7 providing information in accordance with section 217.30,
- 8 subsection 2, paragraph "b", that a person living in that home
- 9 has committed a sexual offense.
- 10 EXPLANATION
- 11 This bill authorizes the department of human services to
- 12 disclose information to a client regarding the presence of a
- 13 perpetrator of a sexual offense in the client's home.
- 14 The bill amends Code section 217.30, relating to
- 15 confidentiality of the department of human services' records,
- 16 to authorize the department to disclose information in those
- 17 records indicating that a person living in a client's home has
- 18 committed a sexual offense. "Committed a sexual offense" is
- 19 defined as meaning the person is required to register with the
- 20 sex offender registry in accordance with Code chapter 692A, or
- 21 the person is listed in the child or dependent adult abuse
- 22 registry as having been found to have committed abuse that was
- 23 sexual in nature. The department may provide the information
- 24 to the adult persons living in the client's home.
- 25 The department records under Code section 217.30 which may
- 26 contain information regarding a perpetrator of a sexual
- 27 offense include identifying information concerning individuals
- 28 receiving services or assistance from the department,
- 29 information about the types of services or amounts of
- 30 assistance provided, agency evaluations of information about a
- 31 particular individual, and medical or psychiatric data
- 32 concerning a particular individual.
- 33 Code sections 235A.15, relating to authorized access to the
- 34 child abuse registry, 235B.6, relating to authorized access to
- 35 the dependent adult abuse registry, and 692A.13, relating to

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1 access to the sex offender registry, are amended to
 2 specifically authorize the department to disclose the
 3 information in those registries as required by the bill.
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
