1 Section 1. Section 455B.183, Code 2003, is amended by  
2 adding the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 4. A publicly owned disposal system shall  
4 not be required to obtain or to be in compliance with  
5 amendments to the requirements of the operation permit for the  
6 disposal system, when such amendments are required by the  
7 rules of the commission in response to a change by the  
8 commission in the use designation of a cold water stream  
9 receiving the discharge of the disposal system, until the  
10 commission, by rule, adopts and publishes scientifically sound  
11 methods for the review of use designations of cold water  
12 streams in the state.

13 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of  
14 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

15 EXPLANATION

16 This bill relates to operation permits for public disposal  
17 systems.

18 The bill provides that a publicly owned disposal system  
19 shall not be required to obtain or to be in compliance with  
20 amendments to the requirements of the operation permit for the  
21 disposal system, when such amendments are required by the  
22 rules of the commission in response to a change by the  
23 commission in the use designation of a cold water stream  
24 receiving the discharge of the disposal system, until the  
25 commission, by rule, adopts and publishes scientifically sound  
26 methods for the review of use designations of cold water  
27 streams in the state.

28 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
