 2 2003, is amended to read as follows:
      At least sixty-nine days before each judicial election, the
 4 state commissioner of elections shall certify to the county
 5 commissioner of elections of each county a list of the judges
 6 of the supreme court, court of appeals, and district court
7 including district associate judges, full-time associate
8 juvenile judges, and full-time associate probate judges, and
 9 clerks of the district court to be voted on in each county at
10 that election. The county commissioner of elections shall
11 place the names upon the ballot in the order in which they
12 appear in the certificate; -unless-only-one-county-is-voting
             The state commissioner of elections shall rotate the
13 thereon.
14 names in the certificate by county,-or-the-county-commissioner
15 of-elections-shall-rotate-them-upon-the-ballot-by-precinct-if
