Section 1. Section 481A.123, Code 2003, is amended by 2 adding the following new subsection: NEW SUBSECTION. 3. This section does not apply to the 4 discharge of a firearm for the purpose of target shooting on 5 premises posted as a target shooting range, if the premises 6 have been used as a target shooting range for at least two 7 years prior to the erection of a building inhabited by people . 8 or domestic livestock, or prior to the construction of a 9 feedlot, located within two hundred yards of the target 10 shooting range. 11 As used in this subsection, "target shooting" means the 12 discharge of a firearm at an inanimate object, for amusement 13 or as a test of skill in marksmanship. 14 EXPLANATION 15 This bill provides that target shooting on premises posted 16 as a target shooting range is exempt from the requirement that 17 a firearm cannot be discharged within 200 yards of a building 18 inhabited by people or domestic livestock, or of a feedlot, 19 unless the owner or tenant has given consent, if the premises 20 have been used as a target shooting range for at least two 21 years prior to the erection of such a building or construction 22 of a feedlot. For the purposes of the bill, "target shooting" 23 means the discharge of a firearm at an inanimate object, for 24 amusement or as a test of skill in marksmanship. A violation 25 of Code section 481A.123 is punishable by a scheduled fine of 26 \$25 under Code section 805.8B. 27 28 29 30 31 32 33
