STATE GOVERNMENT

1 Section 1. Section 80D.3, subsection 1, Code 2003, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 1. Each person appointed to serve as a reserve peace
4 officer shall satisfactorily complete a minimum training
5 course as provided in this section.

6 a. In-addition, if If a reserve peace officer is
7 authorized to carry weapons, the officer shall satisfactorily
8 complete the same training course in the use of weapons as is
9 required for basic training of regular peace officers by the
10 Iowa law enforcement academy.

11 b. If a reserve peace officer is authorized to engage in a
12 chase utilizing a motor vehicle, the officer shall
13 satisfactorily complete a training course in that area either
14 sponsored or approved by the Iowa law enforcement academy.

15 c. The minimum training course for reserve peace officers
16 must be satisfactorily completed within four years from the
17 date of appointment. If reserve officer training received
18 before July 1, 1990, meets the requirements of this section,
19 the training may be applied to meet the minimum training
20 course requirements of this section.

21 EXPLANATION

22 This bill requires that a reserve peace officer who may
23 engage in a chase involving a motor vehicle obtain special
24 training in that area.
