Section 1. Section 298.3, Code Supplement 2003, is amended 1 2 by adding the following new subsections: NEW SUBSECTION. 13. The purchase of athletic uniforms, 4 equipment, and supplies, and for other non-infrastructure-5 related purposes involving the maintenance of athletic 6 training programs and participation in athletic competitions, 7 contests, or events. NEW SUBSECTION. 14. The purchase of equipment, materials, 9 and inventory utilized in the study and presentation of the 10 performing and fine arts, including dance, music, theater, and 11 visual arts, and utilized in foreign language instruction. Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY. This Act is applicable for levies 12 13 imposed either through board authorization or voter approval 14 on or after the effective date of this Act. 15 EXPLANATION This bill provides for additional authorized uses of 16 17 revenue derived by a school district from imposition of the 18 physical plant and equipment levy. The bill provides that 19 revenue may be utilized for the purchase of athletic uniforms, 20 equipment, and supplies, and for other non-infrastructure-21 related purposes involving the maintenance of athletic 22 training programs and participation in athletic competitions, 23 contests, or events. The bill also provides that physical 24 plant and equipment levy revenue may be utilized for the 25 purchase of equipment, materials, and inventory utilized in 26 the study and presentation of the performing and fine arts, 27 including dance, music, theater, and visual arts, and utilized 28 in foreign language instruction. The bill provides that the additional uses shall be 30 authorized for levies imposed either through board 31 authorization or voter approval on or after the bill's 32 effective date.
