1 Section 1. GENERAL STATE FINANCIAL AID TO COMMUNITY
2 COLLEGES. There is appropriated from the general fund of the
3 state to the department of education for the fiscal year
4 beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005, the
5 following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be
6 used for the purpose designated:
