1 An Act relating to the authorization of an instant lottery game  
2 providing aid for veterans.

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 99G.9A INSTANT LOTTERY GAME  
2 PROVIDING AID FOR VETERANS.

3 The chief executive officer, in consultation with the  
4 board, shall develop and conduct a new instant lottery game  
5 annually to provide moneys for the benefit of veterans and  
6 their spouses and dependents. The moneys received from the  
7 sale of tickets for each instant lottery game shall be  
8 deposited in a special account in the lottery fund.

9 Notwithstanding section 99G.39, after payment of the prizes  
10 and the deduction of moneys authorized pursuant to section  
11 99G.39, subsection 1, the remaining moneys shall be  
12 transferred to the veterans trust fund established pursuant to  
13 section 35A.13.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill provides that the chief executive officer of the  
16 lottery authority shall develop and conduct an annual instant  
17 lottery game for the benefit of veterans. Moneys received  
18 from the game, less prizes and expenses, shall be deposited in  
19 the veterans trust fund, currently controlled by the  
20 commission of veterans affairs, for the benefit of veterans  
21 and their spouses and dependents.
