1 An Act requiring a study of the feasibility of creating a state
2 native prairie preserve in the loess hills.

1 Section 1. LOESS HILL STUDY AND REPORT. The natural
2 resource commission, in consultation with the state advisory
3 board for preserves, shall conduct a study to determine the
4 feasibility of designating land in the loess hills for
5 dedication as a state native prairie preserve. The natural
6 resource commission and the state advisory board for preserves
7 shall file a joint report containing their findings and
8 recommendations with the legislative services agency by
9 December 15, 2004, for distribution to the general assembly.

10 EXPLANATION

11 This bill requires the natural resource commission, in
12 consultation with the state advisory board for preserves, to
13 conduct a study to determine the feasibility of designating
14 land in the loess hills for dedication as a state native
15 prairie preserve. The bill also directs the natural resource
16 commission and the state advisory board for preserves to file
17 a joint report containing their findings and recommendations
18 with the legislative services agency by December 15, 2004, for
19 distribution to the general assembly.
