1 Section 1. Section 35A.13, subsection 3, Code Supplement
2 2003, is amended by adding the following new paragraph:

3 NEW PARAGRAPH. c. Admission fees credited to the trust
4 fund pursuant to sections 99D.14, 99F.4A, and 99F.10.

5 Sec. 2. Section 99D.14, Code 2003, is amended by adding
6 the following new subsection:

7 NEW SUBSECTION. 2A. In addition to the admission fee
8 charged under subsection 2, a licensee shall pay to the
9 commission an admission fee of fifty cents for each person
10 subject to the admission fee charged under subsection 2. The
11 admission revenue received by the commission pursuant to this
12 subsection shall be credited to the veterans trust fund
13 created in section 35A.13. The admission fee established
14 under this subsection shall continue to be paid until a total
15 of fifty million dollars has been credited to the veterans
16 trust fund under this subsection, section 99F.4A, subsection
17 4, and section 99F.10, subsection 3A.

18 Sec. 3. Section 99F.4A, subsection 4, Code 2003, is
19 amended to read as follows:

20 4. The fee admission fees imposed in section 99D.14,
21 subsection subsections 2 and 2A, shall be collected for
22 admission to a racetrack enclosure where gambling games are
23 licensed to operate in lieu of the admission fee fees imposed
24 in section 99F.10.

25 Sec. 4. Section 99F.10, Code 2003, is amended by adding
26 the following new subsection:

27 NEW SUBSECTION. 3A. In addition to the admission fees
28 charged under subsections 2 and 3, an excursion boat licensee
29 shall pay to the commission an admission fee of fifty cents
30 for each person subject to the admission fee charged under
31 subsection 2. The admission revenue received by the
32 commission pursuant to this subsection shall be credited to
33 the veterans trust fund created in section 35A.13. The
34 admission fee established under this subsection shall continue
35 to be paid until a total of fifty million dollars has been
