SF 2130 LOCAL GOVERNMENT

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 142B.6A LOCAL REGULATION OF  
2 SMOKING.

3 1. In order to minimize the toxic effects of tobacco smoke  
4 and to protect the health and well-being of the public, and  
5 notwithstanding any conflicting provision of this chapter,  
6 local laws and regulations may be adopted to provide for the  
7 enforcement, by ordinance or other legal means, of the  
8 provisions of this chapter and may establish more specific or  
9 stringent controls, additional prohibitions, or increased  
10 penalties relating to smoking in a public place.

11 2. Specifically, a local law may eliminate or limit the  
12 exemptions specified in section 142B.2, subsection 1, and in  
13 section 142B.2, subsection 3, relating to a bar.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill provides that, in order to minimize the toxic  
16 effects of tobacco smoke and to protect the health and well-  
17 being of the public, and notwithstanding any conflicting  
18 provisions, local laws and regulations may be adopted to  
19 provide for the enforcement of the provisions of Code chapter  
20 142B and may establish more specific or stringent controls,  
21 additional prohibitions, or increased penalties relating to  
22 smoking in a public place. The bill provides that,  
23 specifically, a local law may eliminate or limit the  
24 exemptions relating to designation of a smoking area and the  
25 exemption relating to bars.
