1 repealed. 2 **EXPLANATION** 3 This bill repeals restrictions in the juvenile justice code 4 in Code chapter 232 on court orders for placement of children 5 in group foster care. Under current law, the general assembly annually 7 establishes, in an appropriation made to the department of 8 human services, a statewide expenditure target for children in 9 group foster care placements. Representatives of the 10 department and juvenile court services then allocate the 11 statewide target among the department's service areas based 12 upon a formula. Local representatives of the department and 13 juvenile court services develop a plan for the service area to 14 remain within the expenditure target. State payment for group 15 foster care services is limited to those placements that 16 comply with the plan and the juvenile court is prohibited from 17 ordering a group foster care placement that does not comply 18 with the plan. 19 The bill repeals the expenditure target requirements in 20 Code section 232.143, strikes the Code subsections limiting 21 the juvenile court authority to issue dispositional orders for 22 group foster care placements, and makes conforming changes in 23 related provisions. 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35
