1 Section 1. Section 80B.3, subsection 3, Code 2003, is 2 amended to read as follows: "Law enforcement officer" means an officer appointed by 4 the director of the department of natural resources, a member 5 of a police force or other agency or department of the state, 6 county, or city, or tribal government regularly employed as 7 such and who is responsible for the prevention and detection 8 of crime and the enforcement of the criminal laws of this 9 state and all individuals, as determined by the council, who 10 by the nature of their duties may be required to perform the 11 duties of a peace officer. 12 EXPLANATION 13 This bill relates to tribal law enforcement officer 14 training at the Iowa law enforcement academy. The bill provides that a law enforcement officer of a 15 16 tribal government may receive training and be certified at the 17 Iowa law enforcement academy in the same manner as currently 18 provided for law enforcement officers of a county, city, or 19 the state.
