A BILL FOR 1 An Act providing for the distribution of moneys appropriated for the educational excellence program on a per pupil basis. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 294A.26 DISTRIBUTION OF 2 PAYMENTS.
- 3 1. For the school year beginning July 1, 2005, and
- 4 succeeding school years, amounts deposited in the educational
- 5 excellence fund to meet the requirements of this chapter for
- 6 phase I and phase II pursuant to section 294A.25, subsection
- 7 6, shall be distributed to school districts on a per pupil
- 8 basis. The payments for phase I and phase II shall be
- 9 combined in making the per pupil distribution. School
- 10 districts shall utilize amounts received pursuant to this
- 11 section for payment of the minimum salary supplement for
- 12 teachers employed by the district or area education agency as
- 13 certified to the department of education pursuant to section
- 14 294A.5, and for payment of amounts required pursuant to phase
- 15 II. The department of education shall notify the department
- 16 of administrative services of the per pupil distribution
- 17 amount for each school district and the department of
- 18 administrative services shall make the payments.
- 19 2. If the amount distributed to a school district for
- 20 phase I for a school year is insufficient to pay the amount
- 21 certified to the department of education pursuant to section
- 22 294A.5, the school district shall prorate the payments among
- 23 eligible teachers employed within the district.
- 3. The amount of compensation received by eligible
- 25 teachers pursuant to this section for the school year
- 26 beginning July 1, 2005, shall not be less than the amount
- 27 received for the school year beginning July 1, 2004.
- 28 4. It is the intent of the general assembly that the
- 29 equitable distribution of funding for the educational
- 30 excellence program be included in any future legislative
- 31 interim committee review of the school finance formula.
- 32 Sec. 2. Section 294A.6, Code Supplement 2003, is repealed.
- 33 EXPLANATION
- 34 This bill provides for a new distribution mechanism for
- 35 amounts appropriated for the educational excellence program

1 pursuant to Code chapter 294A.

- 2 Currently, Code chapter 294A provides that amounts
- 3 appropriated for phase I of the program shall be distributed
- 4 to school districts and area education agencies in an amount
- 5 certified by each district to the department of education
- 6 corresponding to the number of teachers employed by the
- 7 district or area education agency whose regular compensation
- 8 falls below specified minimum levels, and that amounts
- 9 appropriated for phase II are distributed on a per pupil
- 10 basis.
- 11 The bill provides that for the school year beginning July
- 12 1, 2005, and succeeding school years, amounts deposited in the
- 13 educational excellence fund for distribution to school
- 14 districts and area education agencies pursuant to phase I and
- 15 phase II of the program shall be distributed on a per pupil
- 16 basis. The bill provides that the payments for phase I and
- 17 phase II shall be combined in making the per pupil
- 18 distribution. The bill provides that school districts shall
- 19 utilize the amounts received for payment of the minimum salary
- 20 supplement for teachers employed by the district or area
- 21 education agency certified to the department of education
- 22 pursuant to Code section 294A.5, and for payment of amounts
- 23 required pursuant to phase II. The department of education
- 24 shall notify the department of administrative services of the
- 25 per pupil distribution amount for each school district, and
- 26 the department of administrative services shall make the
- 27 payments.
- 28 The bill provides that if the amount distributed to a
- 29 school district for phase I is insufficient to pay the amount
- 30 certified, the school district shall prorate the payments
- 31 among eligible teachers employed within the district.
- 32 The bill provides that the amount of compensation received
- 33 by eligible teachers for the school year beginning July 1,
- 34 2005, with the imposition of the new distribution mechanism
- 35 shall not be less than the amount received for the school year
