3 NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. The department may revoke a
4 license for nonpayment of the fee for that license required by
5 section 483A.1. The department may adopt rules to implement
6 this paragraph.

7 EXPLANATION

8 This bill allows the department of natural resources to
9 revoke a fishing or hunting license issued under Code chapter
10 483A for nonpayment of the fee for that license that is
11 required to be paid pursuant to Code section 483A.1. The
12 department may adopt administrative rules regarding the
13 procedural requirements to revoke the licenses for nonpayment
14 of fees.

REGARDING THE CANCELLATION OF FISHING AND HUNTING LICENSES BY THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR NONPAYMENT OF THE LICENSE FEE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 481A.134, Code 2003, is amended to read as follows:

481A.134 AUTHORITY TO CANCEL, SUSPEND, OR REVOKE LICENSE -- POINT SYSTEM.

The department shall establish rules pursuant to chapter 17A providing for the suspension or revocation of licenses issued by the department. The rules may include procedures for summary cancellation of a license based on documentation that the licensee failed to pay the applicable fee for the license. For purposes of determining when to suspend or revoke a license issued by the department under this section, the department shall adopt a point system pursuant to chapter 17A for the purpose of weighing the seriousness of violations of the provisions of this chapter or chapter 481B, 482, 483A,
