**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act providing for the establishment of the state percent of  
2 growth for purposes of the state school foundation program,  
3 and providing an applicability date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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SF 2307  
WAYS & MEANS

1 Section 1. Section 257.8, subsection 1, Code Supplement  
2 2003, is amended to read as follows:

3 1. STATE PERCENT OF GROWTH. ~~The state percent of growth~~  
4 ~~for the budget year beginning July 1, 2003, is two percent.~~  
5 The state percent of growth for the budget year beginning July  
6 1, 2004, is two percent. The state percent of growth for the  
7 budget year beginning July 1, 2005, is three percent. The  
8 state percent of growth for each subsequent budget year shall  
9 be established by statute which shall be enacted within thirty  
10 days of the submission in the year preceding the base year of  
11 the governor's budget under section 8.21. The establishment  
12 of the state percent of growth for a budget year shall be the  
13 only subject matter of the bill which enacts the state percent  
14 of growth for a budget year.

15 Sec. 2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. If the revenue estimating  
16 conference as provided for in section 8.22A agrees to a  
17 revenue estimate of general fund receipts at its December 2004  
18 meeting for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, of at  
19 least four percent over the estimated general fund receipts  
20 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005, it is the intent of  
21 the general assembly that the general assembly meeting in  
22 regular session in 2005 shall establish a state percent of  
23 growth for the budget year beginning July 1, 2005, of four  
24 percent.

25 Sec. 3. Notwithstanding the thirty-day deadline for the  
26 enactment of the state percent of growth provided in section  
27 257.8, subsection 1, such deadline shall not apply to the Act  
28 enacted which establishes the state percent of growth during  
29 the 2004 Regular Session of the Eightieth General Assembly.

30 Sec. 4. APPLICABILITY. This Act is applicable for  
31 computing state aid under the state school foundation program  
32 for the school budget year beginning July 1, 2005.

33 EXPLANATION

34 This bill establishes a state percent of growth of 3  
35 percent for purposes of the state school foundation program

1 for the school budget year beginning July 1, 2005. The bill  
2 also provides that it is the intent of the legislature that if  
3 the revenue estimating conference as provided for in Code  
4 section 8.22A agrees to a revenue estimate of general fund  
5 receipts at its December 2004 meeting for the fiscal year  
6 beginning July 1, 2005, of at least 4 percent over the  
7 estimated general fund receipts for the fiscal year ending  
8 June 30, 2005, the general assembly meeting in regular session  
9 in 2005 shall establish a state percent of growth for the  
10 budget year beginning July 1, 2005, of 4 percent.

11 The bill provides that the provisions of Code section  
12 257.8, subsection 1, establishing a 30-day deadline for the  
13 enactment of the state percent of growth shall not apply to  
14 the Act enacted which establishes the state percent of growth  
15 during the 2004 Regular Session of the Eightieth General  
16 Assembly.

17 The bill is applicable for state aid computation under the  
18 school foundation program for the school budget year beginning  
19 July 1, 2005.

23 shall not apply to the Act enacted which establishes  
24 the state percent of growth during the 2004 Regular  
25 Session of the Eightieth General Assembly.

28 program for the school budget year beginning July 1,  
29 2005."

2 1. By striking everything after the enacting  
3 clause and inserting the following:

4 "Section 1. SCHOOL FINANCE FORMULA APPROPRIATION.  
5 Notwithstanding section 8.22A, subsection 3, or any  
6 other provision of law to the contrary, the revenue  
7 estimate agreed to by the revenue estimating  
8 conference at its March 19, 2004, meeting shall be  
9 used in determining the state general fund expenditure  
10 limitation for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004.  
11 The amount of the increase in the expenditure  
12 limitation over the limitation based upon the revenue  
13 estimate agreed to by the revenue estimating  
14 conference at its December 8, 2003, meeting shall be  
15 appropriated to the department of education for  
16 distribution pursuant to section 257.16 to pay  
17 foundation aid and supplementary aid under section  
18 257.4, subsection 2. The amount appropriated in this  
19 section shall be distributed on a per pupil basis to  
20 school districts based upon the district's budget  
21 enrollment."

20 December 2004 meeting for the fiscal year beginning July 1,  
21 2005, of at least four percent over the actual general fund  
22 receipts for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, the state  
23 percent of growth for the budget year beginning July 1, 2005,  
24 is four percent.

25 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the thirty-day deadline for the  
26 enactment of the state percent of growth provided in section  
27 257.8, subsection 1, such deadline shall not apply to the Act  
28 enacted which establishes the state percent of growth during  
29 the 2004 Regular Session of the Eightieth General Assembly.

30 Sec. 3. APPLICABILITY. This Act is applicable for

34 This bill establishes a state percent of growth of 3

2 provides that, notwithstanding the 3 percent figure, in the  
3 event that the revenue estimating conference as provided for  
4 in Code section 8.22A agrees to a general fund revenue  
5 estimate at its December 2004 meeting for the fiscal year  
6 beginning July 1, 2005, of at least 4 percent over the actual  
7 general fund receipts for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
8 2004, the state percent of growth for the budget year  
9 beginning July 1, 2005, shall be 4 percent.

10 The bill provides that the provisions of Code section  
11 257.8, subsection 1, establishing a 30-day deadline for the  
12 enactment of the state percent of growth shall not apply to  
13 the Act enacted which establishes the state percent of growth  
14 during the 2004 Regular Session of the Eightieth General  
15 Assembly.

16 The bill is applicable for state aid computation under the  
17 school foundation program for the school budget year beginning  
18 July 1, 2005.

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
