Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 249A.32 INMATES -- ELIGIBILITY.
1. The department shall provide coverage under the medical
3 assistance program to eligible juveniles and adults who are
4 accused of a crime and are in the custody of the juvenile or
5 adult criminal justice system.

6 2. If eligibility under the medical assistance program is 7 suspended for an individual convicted of a crime who is an 8 inmate of a public institution, the department shall 9 redetermine the inmate's eligibility prior to release of the 10 inmate from the public institution in order to provide the 11 inmate with coverage under the medical assistance program 12 immediately upon release. For the purposes of this 13 subsection, "inmate of a public institution" means as provided 14 in 42 C.F.R. § 435.1008.

## EXPLANATION

16 This bill relates to persons in the custody of the juvenile 17 or criminal justice system and inmates of public institutions 18 and their eligibility under the medical assistance program. 19 The bill requires the department of human services to 20 provide coverage under the medical assistance program to 21 eligible juveniles and adults who are accused of a crime and 22 are in the custody of the juvenile or adult criminal justice 23 system.

The bill also provides that if the eligibility under the medical assistance program of an individual who has been convicted of a crime and is an inmate of a public institution has been suspended, the department must redetermine the inmate's eligibility prior to release in order to provide coverage under the medical assistance program immediately upon the inmate's release.
