A BILL FOR

1 An Act authorizing the issuance of special registration plates to 2 owners of motor trucks.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321.34, subsection 3, Code 2003, is amended to read as follows:
3. RADIO OPERATORS PLATES. The owner of an automobile, ł̇ght-dełivery-truekf-paneł-dełiもery-truek; motorcycle, trailer, or piekup motor truck who holds an amateur radio license issued by the federal communications commission may, upon written application to the county treasurer accompanied by a fee of five dollars, order special registration plates bearing the call letters authorized the radio station covered aid fee shall be in addition to and not in lieu of the fee

Sec. 2. Section 321.34, subsection 8, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2003, is amended to read as follows:

The owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration under section 321.109 , subsection l, łight-dełivery-eruekt-paneł dełitery-truek, motorcycle, trailer, or piekup motor truck who has been awarded the congressional medal of honor may, upon written application to the department, order special registration plates which shall be red, white, and blue in color and shall bear an emblem of the congressional medal of honor and an identifying number. Each applicant applying for special registration plates under this subsection may purchase only one set of registration plates under this subsection. The application is subject to approval by the department and

14 The owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration under 15 section 321.109 , subsection $1, \nsucceq \dot{\text { ght-dełivery-truekf-paneł }}$ 16 dełivery-truek motorcycle, trailer, or piekup motor truck who 17 was a prisoner of war during the Second World War at any time 18 between December 7, 1941, and December 31, 1946, the Korean 19 Conflict at any time between June 25, 1950, and January 31, 20 1955, or the Vietnam Conflict at any time between August 5, 21 1964, and June 30, 1973, all dates inclusive, may, upon written application to the department, order only one set of special registration plates with an ex-prisoner of war processed emblem. The emblem shall be designed by the department in cooperation with the adjutant general and shall signify that the owner was a prisoner of war as described in this subsection. The application is subject to approval by the department, in consultation with the adjutant general. The special plates shall be issued at no charge and are subject to an annual registration fee of fifteen dollars. The county treasurer shall validate the special plates in the same 2 manner as regular registration plates are validated under this section.

Sec. 4. Section 321.34 , subsections 10 and 10A, Code 2003, 35 are amended to read as follows:

10. FIRE FIGHTER PLATES. The owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration pursuant to section 321.109, subsection l, łight-dełivery-truek,-paneł-dełivery-truekt piekup motor truck, motor home, multipurpose vehicle, motorcycle, trailer, or travel trailer who is a current or former member of a paid or volunteer fire department, may upon written application to the department, order special registration plates, designed by the department in cooperation with representatives designated by the Iowa fire fighters' associations, which plates signify that the applicant is a current or former member of a paid or volunteer fire department. The application shall be approved by the department, in consultation with representatives designated by the Iowa fire fighters' associations, and the special registration plates shall be issued to the applicant in exchange for the registration plates previously issued to the person. The fee for the special plates shall be twenty-five dollars which shall be in addition to the regular annual registration fee. The department shall validate the special plates in the same manner as regular registration plates are validated under this section at the regular annual registration fee.

10A. EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PLATES. The owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration pursuant to section 321.109, subsection l, łight-dełivery-truek,-paneł-dełivery truek-piekup; motor truck, motor home, multipurpose vehicle, motorcycle, trailer, or travel trailer who is a current member of a paid or volunteer emergency medical services agency may, upon written application to the department, order special registration plates, designed by the department in cooperation with representatives designated by the Iowa emergency medical services association, which plates signify that the applicant is a current member of a paid or volunteer emergency medical services agency. The application shall be approved by the department, in consultation with representatives designated by

10 Sec. 5. Section 321.34, subsection 11, paragraph a, Code 11 2003, is amended to read as follows:
the Iowa emergency medical services association, and the special registration plates shall be issued to the applicant in exchange for the registration plates previously issued to the person. The fee for the special plates shall be twentyfive dollars which shall be in addition to the regular annual registration fee. The department shall validate the special plates in the same manner as regular registration plates are validated under this section at the regular annual
a. Upon application and payment of the proper fees, the director may issue natural resources plates to the owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration under section 321.109 ,
 piekup, motor truck, motor home, multipurpose vehicle, motorcycle, trailer, or travel trailer.

Sec. 6. Section 321.34 , subsection llA, paragraph a, Code 2003, is amended to read as follows:
a. Upon application and payment of the proper fees, the director may issue "love our kids" plates to the owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration under section 321.109 ,
 piekup; motor truck, motor home, multipurpose vehicle, motorcycle, trailer, or travel trailer.

Sec. 7. Section 321.34 , subsection llB, paragraph a, Code 2003, is amended to read as follows:
a. Upon application and payment of the proper fees, the director may issue "motorcycle rider education" plates to the owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration under section

Sec. 8. Section 321.34 , subsection 12 , paragraph a, Code 2003, is amended to read as follows:

a．The owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration pursuant to section 321.109 ，subsection 1 ，$\ddagger$ ight－dełivery truek；－paneł－dełivery－truek；－piekup；motor truck，motor home， multipurpose vehicle，motorcycle，trailer，or travel trailer may，upon written application to the department，order special registration plates with a distinguishing processed emblem as authorized by this section or as approved by the department． The fee for the issuance of special registration plates is twenty－five dollars for each vehicle，unless otherwise provided by this section，which fee is in addition to the regular annual registration fee．The county treasurer shall validate special registration plates with a distinguishing processed emblem in the same manner as regular registration plates，upon payment of five dollars in addition to the regular annual registration fee．

Sec．9．Section 321.34 ，subsection 15 ，unnumbered paragraph l，Code 2003，is amended to read as follows：

The owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration under section 321.109 ，subsection l，łight－deł̇もery－truekr－paneł dełt甘eryーtruekt motorcycle，trailer，or piekup motor truck， who has been awarded the legion of merit may，upon written application to the department and presentation of satisfactory proof of the award of the legion of merit as established by the Congress of the United States，order special registration plates with a legion of merit processed emblem．The emblem shall be designed by the department in cooperation with the adjutant general and shall signify that the owner was awarded the legion of merit．The application is subject to approval by the department，in consultation with the adjutant general． The special plates shall be issued at no charge and are subject to an annual registration fee of fifteen dollars．The county treasurer shall validate the special plates in the same manner as regular registration plates are validated under this section．

1 Under current law, the only truck owners eligible for 2 special motor vehicle registration plates issued by the state 3 department of transportation are owners of light delivery 4 trucks, panel delivery trucks, and pickups. This bill amends 5 Code section 321.34 to allow the owner of any motor truck to 6 order special registration plates.
