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Section 1. Section 249A.4, Code 2003, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection: NEW SUBSECTION. 16. Report annually by December 15 to the 4 governor and general assembly with a cost-benefit analysis of 5 the contract for managed care of adult substance abuse and 6 mental health services, any contract for insuring groups or 7 individuals as authorized in subsection 4, any contract for 8 processing and payment of claims as authorized in subsection 9 5, and any other contract for services that were previously 10 managed or performed directly by the department within the 11 ten-year period preceding the issuance date of the report. 12 The report shall include information on the potential costs or 13 cost savings for the department to reassume the management or 14 performance of the contracted services. 15 EXPLANATION This bill amends Code section 249A.4, relating to the 17 duties of the director of human services under the medical 18 assistance (Medicaid) program, to require an annual report on 19 contracted services. The report is to provide a cost-benefit 20 analysis of the contract for managed care of adult substance 21 abuse and mental health services, any contract for group 22 health insurance, any contract for health maintenance 23 organization services, and any other contract for Medicaid 24 services that were directly performed or managed by the 25 department during the 10-year period preceding the issuance 26 date of the report. The report is required to include 27 information on the potential costs or cost savings for the 28 department to assume the management or performance of the 29 contracted services. 30 31 32 33 34
