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A BILL FOR
 1 An Act relating to discrimination based upon a person's sexual
      orientation under the Iowa civil rights Act.
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 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
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SF 33 STATE GOVERNMENT

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- 1 Section 1. Section 216.2, Code 2003, is amended by adding
- 2 the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 12A. "Sexual orientation" means actual or
- 4 perceived heterosexuality, homosexuality, bisexuality, or a
- 5 person's attributes in behavior, practice, or appearance as
- 6 they are understood to be masculine or feminine. "Sexual
- 7 orientation" does not include participation in acts which are
- 8 prohibited by law.
- 9 Sec. 2. Section 216.5, subsections 6 and 8, Code 2003, are
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 6. To issue such publications and reports of
- 12 investigations and research as in the judgment of the
- 13 commission shall tend to promote good will among the various
- 14 racial, religious, and ethnic groups of the state and which
- 15 shall tend to minimize or eliminate discrimination in public
- 16 accommodations, employment, apprenticeship and on-the-job
- 17 training programs, vocational schools, or housing because of
- 18 race, creed, color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin,
- 19 religion, ancestry, or disability.
- 20 8. To make recommendations to the general assembly for
- 21 such further legislation concerning discrimination because of
- 22 race, creed, color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin,
- 23 religion, ancestry, or disability as it may deem necessary and
- 24 desirable.
- 25 Sec. 3. Section 216.6, subsection 1, paragraphs a, b, and
- 26 c, Code 2003, are amended to read as follows:
- 27 a. Person to refuse to hire, accept, register, classify,
- 28 or refer for employment, to discharge any employee, or to
- 29 otherwise discriminate in employment against any applicant for
- 30 employment or any employee because of the age, race, creed,
- 31 color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, religion, or
- 32 disability of such applicant or employee, unless based upon
- 33 the nature of the occupation. If a person with a disability
- 34 is qualified to perform a particular occupation, by reason of
- 35 training or experience, the nature of that occupation shall

1 not be the basis for exception to the unfair or discriminating 2 practices prohibited by this subsection. Labor organization or the employees, agents, or members 4 thereof to refuse to admit to membership any applicant, to 5 expel any member, or to otherwise discriminate against any 6 applicant for membership or any member in the privileges, 7 rights, or benefits of such membership because of the age, 8 race, creed, color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, 9 religion, or disability of such applicant or member. 10 Employer, employment agency, labor organization, or the ll employees, agents, or members thereof to directly or 12 indirectly advertise or in any other manner indicate or 13 publicize that individuals of any particular age, race, creed, 14 color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, religion, or 15 disability are unwelcome, objectionable, not acceptable, or 16 not solicited for employment or membership unless based on the 17 nature of the occupation. If a person with a disability is 18 qualified to perform a particular occupation by reason of 19 training or experience, the nature of that occupation shall 20 not be the basis for exception to the unfair or discriminating 21 practices prohibited by this subsection. 22 An employer, employment agency, or their employees, 23 servants, or agents may offer employment or advertise for 24 employment to only persons with disabilities, when other 25 applicants have available to them other employment compatible 26 with their ability which would not be available to persons 27 with disabilities because of their disabilities. 28 employment or offer of employment shall not discriminate among

- 21 objectionable, not acceptable, or not solicited.
- 22 Sec. 6. Section 216.7, subsection 2, paragraph a, Code
- 23 2003, is amended to read as follows:
- 24 a. Any bona fide religious institution with respect to any
- 25 qualifications the institution may impose based on religion or
- 26 sexual orientation when such qualifications are related to a
- 27 bona fide religious purpose.
- 28 Sec. 7. Section 216.8, subsections 1 through 4, Code 2003,
- 29 are amended to read as follows:
- To refuse to sell, rent, lease, assign, sublease,
- 31 refuse to negotiate, or to otherwise make unavailable, or deny
- 32 any real property or housing accommodation or part, portion or
- 33 interest therein, to any person because of the race, color,
- 34 creed, sex, sexual orientation, religion, national origin,
- 35 disability, or familial status of such person.

To discriminate against any person because of the person's race, color, creed, sex, sexual orientation, religion, national origin, disability, or familial status, in the terms, conditions or privileges of the sale, rental, lease assignment or sublease of any real property or housing accommodation or any part, portion or interest in the real property or housing accommodation or in the provision of services or facilities in connection with the real property or
- For purposes of this section, "person" means one or more individuals, corporations, partnerships, associations, labor corporations, legal representatives, mutual companies, joint stock companies, trusts, unincorporated organizations, trustees, trustees in cases under Title 11 of the United States Code, receivers, and fiduciaries.

To directly or indirectly advertise, or in any other manner indicate or publicize that the purchase, rental, lease, 18 assignment, or sublease of any real property or housing 19 accommodation or any part, portion or interest therein, by 20 persons of any particular race, color, creed, sex, sexual 21 orientation, religion, national origin, disability, or 22 familial status is unwelcome, objectionable, not acceptable or 23 not solicited.

To discriminate against the lessee or purchaser of any real property or housing accommodation or part, portion or interest of the real property or housing accommodation, or against any prospective lessee or purchaser of the property or accommodation, because of the race, color, creed, religion, sex, sexual orientation, disability, age, or national origin of persons who may from time to time be present in or on the lessee's or owner's premises for lawful purposes at the invitation of the lessee or owner as friends, guests, visitors, relatives or in any similar capacity.

- 28 status, sex, sexual orientation, physical disability, or

- 2. Person authorized or licensed to do business in this
- 31 state pursuant to chapter 524, 533, 534, 536, or 536A to
- 32 refuse to loan or extend credit or to impose terms or

- 11 The provisions of this section shall not be construed by
- 12 negative implication or otherwise to narrow or restrict any

- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 l. Any bona fide religious institution with respect to any
- 17 qualifications it may impose based on religion or sexual
- 18 orientation, when the qualifications are related to a bona
- 19 fide religious purpose unless the religious institution owns
- 20 or operates property for a commercial purpose or membership in
- 21 the religion is restricted on account of race, color, or
- 22 national origin.
- 23 Sec. 15. Section 216.12A, Code 2003, is amended to read as
- 24 follows:
- 25 216.12A ADDITIONAL HOUSING EXCEPTION.
- 26 Sections 216.8 and 216.8A do not prohibit a person engaged
- 27 in the business of furnishing appraisals of real estate from
- 28 taking into consideration factors other than race, color,
- 29 creed, sex, sexual orientation, religion, national origin,
- 30 disability, or familial status in appraising real estate.
- 31 EXPLANATION
- 32 This bill defines "sexual orientation" and prohibits
- 33 discriminatory employment, public accommodation, housing,
- 34 education, and credit practices based upon a person's sexual
- 35 orientation. However, the bill does allow for the imposition
