A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the deposit and use of moneys received by
2 cities and counties for assumption of jurisdiction of primary
3 roads and providing effective and retroactive applicability
4 dates.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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SF 318

1 Section 1. Section 306.8, Code 2003, is amended by adding
2 the following new unnumbered paragraph:

3 NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. Any moneys, and any interest or
4 other earnings on the moneys, received by a county or city for
5 assumption of jurisdiction of a primary road pursuant to this
6 section or otherwise shall be deposited by the county into the
7 county's secondary road fund and by the city into a special
8 fund or account to be used only for road purposes.

9 Sec. 2. IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE AND RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY
10 DATES.

11 1. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes
12 effect upon enactment.

13 2. This Act applies retroactively to transfers of
14 jurisdiction of primary roads occurring on or after January 1,
15 2002, for which moneys are received by a county or city on or
16 after the effective date of this Act.

17 EXPLANATION

18 This bill directs counties and cities to deposit any moneys
19 received for the assumption of jurisdiction of primary roads
20 in the county's secondary road fund or a special fund or
21 account established by the city to be used solely for road
22 purposes.

23 The bill takes effect upon enactment and applies to
24 transfers of jurisdiction of primary roads occurring on or
25 after January 1, 2002, for which moneys are received on or
26 after the effective date of the bill.
