1 Section 1. Section 15F.304, subsection 4, Code 2003, is
2 amended to read as follows:

4. Upon review of the recommendations of the review
4 committee, the board shall approve, defer, or deny the
5 applications. If an application is approved, the board may
6 <u>shall</u> enter into an agreement with the applicant to provide
7 financial assistance authorized under section 15F.302. To the
8 <u>extent practicable, the department shall adopt administrative</u>
9 <u>rules detailing procedural rules for the application approval</u>
10 <u>process and substantive rules setting out criteria used in the</u>
11 application evaluation and approval process.

## EXPLANATION

13 This bill relates to agreements for financial assistance 14 under the vision Iowa program.

15 The bill provides that, if an application for financial 16 assistance is approved, the vision Iowa board is required to 17 enter into an agreement with the applicant for financial 18 assistance. The bill requires the department to adopt 19 administrative rules that, to the extent practicable, detail 20 procedural rules for the application approval process and 21 provide substantive rules setting out criteria used in the 22 application evaluation and approval process.
