1 An Act relating to the animal agriculture compliance Act, and
2 providing for penalties.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 459.103, subsection 3, Code 2003, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 3. The department and the attorney general shall enforce
4 the provisions of ~~this chapter in~~ subchapters II and III using
5 the same manner administrative and judicial procedures as
6 provided in chapter 455B, ~~division-17~~, unless otherwise
7 provided in this chapter.

8 Sec. 2. Section 459.307, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code
9 2003, is amended to read as follows:

10 The department shall adopt rules establishing construction
11 design standards for formed manure storage structures that are
12 part of confinement feeding operations other than small animal
13 feeding operations. However, the construction design

31 section 459.307 and shall ensure that the proposed formed
32 manure storage structure will provide a higher degree of
33 environmental protection than existing manure storage and
34 handling facilities. If the proposed formed manure storage
35 structure will replace any existing manure storage structure,

1 the department shall, as a condition of granting the
2 exception, require that any existing manure storage structure
3 be properly closed.

4 Sec. 5. Section 459.602, Code 2003, is amended to read as

7 A person who violates subchapter II shall be subject to a
8 civil penalty, including a fine or civil penalty, which shall

12 agriculture compliance fund created in section 459.401.

23 EXPLANATION

24 This bill relates to provisions under the "Animal
25 Agriculture Compliance Act" regulating animal feeding
26 operations by the department of natural resources (DNR) which
27 were amended, enacted, and consolidated in Code chapter 459
28 during the 2002 legislative sessions pursuant to Senate File
29 2293 and House File 2627 (2002 Iowa Acts, ch. 1137, and 2002
30 Iowa Acts, Second Extraordinary Session, ch. 1003).

31 As consolidated, Code chapter 459 includes a number of
32 subchapters (subchapter I contains general provisions,
33 subchapter II regulates air quality, subchapter III requires
34 permits and regulates water quality, subchapter IV establishes
35 an animal agriculture compliance fund and associated fees,

1 subchapter V establishes a manure storage indemnity fund, and
2 subchapter VI provides for enforcement).

3 WATER QUALITY -- DISTANCE REQUIREMENTS. The bill amends
4 Code section 459.310, which in part provides that a
5 confinement feeding operation structure cannot be constructed
6 closer than a certain number of feet from groundwater inlets
7 or surface water (the surface intake of an agricultural
8 drainage well, wellhead, cistern of an agricultural drainage
9 well, known sinkhole, water source, or wetland). The bill
10 provides an exception to the prohibition.

11 The department may grant an exception from the requirements
12 for a proposed formed manure storage structure that will be
13 part of a small animal feeding operation that commenced
14 operating prior to March 1, 2003. The bill provides that in
15 granting the exception, the proposed formed manure storage
16 structure must comply with standards adopted pursuant to Code
17 section 459.307 and must ensure that the proposed formed
18 manure storage structure will provide a higher degree of
19 environmental protection than existing manure storage and
20 handling facilities. The bill also provides for the closure
21 of the existing manure storage structure.

22 ENFORCEMENT. Code section 459.103 in part requires the DNR
23 and the attorney general to enforce the provisions of Code
24 chapter 459 in the same manner as provided in Code chapter
25 455B, division I. The bill amends the provision to provide
26 that the DNR or the attorney general may enforce subchapters
27 II and III of Code chapter 459 using the same administrative
28 and judicial enforcement procedures and remedies as provided
29 in Code chapter 455B.

30 Code section 459.602 provides for civil penalties that may
31 be assessed for violations of subchapter II and Code section
32 459.603 provides for civil penalties that may be assessed for
33 violations of subchapter III. Code section 459.602 provides
34 that a violator is subject to Code section 455B.109, which
35 provides for administrative assessment of civil penalties of

1 up to \$10,000, while Code section 459.603 provides that a
2 violator is subject to Code section 455B.191, which provides
3 for a civil penalty of \$5,000, and court-imposed penalties.
4 The bill provides that for a violation of subchapter II, the
5 penalties of Code chapter 455B, division II, and Code section
6 455B.109 apply. The bill provides that for a violation of
7 subchapter III, the penalties of Code chapter 455B, division
8 III, and Code section 455B.109 apply.

RELATING TO THE ANIMAL AGRICULTURE COMPLIANCE ACT, PROVIDING
FOR PENALTIES, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 459.307, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2003, is amended to read as follows:

The department shall adopt rules establishing construction design standards for formed manure storage structures that are part of confinement feeding operations other than small animal feeding operations. However, the construction design standards shall apply to a formed manure storage structure that is part of a small animal feeding operation as provided in section 459.310.

Sec. 2. Section 459.308, subsection 3, Code 2003, is amended to read as follows:

3. A person shall not construct an unformed manure storage structure on karst terrain or on an area that drains into a known sinkhole. However, a person may construct an unformed manure storage structure, if there is a twenty-five foot vertical separation distance between the bottom of the unformed manure storage structure and underlying limestone, dolomite, or other soluble rock.

Sec. 3. Section 459.310, subsection 1, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2003, is amended to read as follows:

Except as provided in subsection subsections 3 and 3A, the following shall apply:

2. A Except as provided in subsection 3A, a confinement feeding operation structure shall not be constructed on land that is part of a one hundred year floodplain as designated by rules adopted by the department pursuant to section 459.301.

Sec. 5. Section 459.310, Code 2003, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 3A. A separation distance required in subsection 1 or the prohibition against construction of a confinement feeding operation structure on a one hundred year floodplain as provided in subsection 2 shall not apply to a confinement feeding operation that includes a confinement feeding operation structure that was constructed prior to March 1, 2003, if any of the following apply:

a. One or more unformed manure storage structures that is part of the confinement feeding operation is replaced with one or more formed manure storage structures on or after the effective date of this Act, and all of the following apply:

(1) The animal weight capacity or animal unit capacity, whichever is applicable, is not increased for that portion of the confinement feeding operation that utilizes all replacement formed manure storage structures.

(2) The use of each replaced unformed manure storage structure is discontinued within one year after the construction of the replacement formed manure storage structure.

(3) The capacity of all replacement formed manure storage structures does not exceed the amount required to store manure produced by that portion of the confinement feeding operation utilizing the formed manure storage structures during any eighteen-month period.

(4) No portion of the replacement formed manure storage structure is closer to the location or object from which separation is required under subsection 1 than any other confinement feeding operation structure which is part of the operation.

(5) The formed manure storage structure meets or exceeds the requirements of section 459.307.

b. A formed manure storage structure that is part of the confinement feeding operation is constructed on or after the effective date of this Act pursuant to a variance granted by the department. In granting the variance, the department shall make a finding of all of the following:

(1) The replacement formed manure storage structure replaces the confinement feeding operation's existing manure storage and handling facilities.

(2) The replacement formed manure storage structure complies with standards adopted pursuant to section 459.307.

(3) The replacement formed manure storage structure more likely than not provides a higher degree of environmental protection than the confinement feeding operation's existing manure storage and handling facilities.

If the formed manure storage structure will replace any existing manure storage structure, the department shall, as a condition of granting the variance, require that the replaced manure storage structure be properly closed.

Sec. 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
