1 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
2 the State of Iowa is proposed:

3 Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Iowa is
4 amended by adding the following new section:

5 SNOWMOBILE REGISTRATION FEES. SEC. 10. All revenue
6 derived from state registration fees for snowmobiles shall be
7 used exclusively for the performance and administration of
8 activities and programs related to snowmobiling.

9 Sec. 2. REFERRAL AND PUBLICATION. The foregoing proposed
10 amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa is referred
11 to the General Assembly to be chosen at the next general
12 election for members of the General Assembly, and the
13 Secretary of State is directed to cause the same to be
14 published for three consecutive months previous to the date of
15 that election as provided by law.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This joint resolution proposes an amendment to the
18 Constitution of the State of Iowa relating to snowmobile
19 registration fees. The amendment requires that fees charged
20 by the state for the registration of snowmobiles be dedicated
21 for the performance and administration of snowmobile
22 activities and programs. The resolution, if adopted, would be
23 referred to the next general assembly before being submitted
24 to the electorate for ratification.
