Section 1. 491 Iowa administrative code, rule 1.6, subrule 2 l, is nullified. Sec. 2. This joint resolution, being deemed of immediate 4 importance, takes effect upon enactment. EXPLANATION This joint resolution nullifies an administrative rule 7 adopted by the racing and gaming commission limiting the 8 number of licenses to conduct horse racing to one, the number 9 of licenses to conduct dog racing to two, and the number of 10 licenses to conduct gambling games on excursion boats to 10, 11 restricted to the counties where such boats were operating as 12 of May 1, 1998. The joint resolution takes effect upon enactment.
