Section 1. Article IX of the Constitution of the State of 2 Iowa is amended by adding the following new section: FREE PUBLIC SCHOOLS. 3 SEC. 16. The General Assembly shall provide a basic system of free 5 quality public elementary and secondary schools. The system 6 shall guarantee equality of educational opportunity. 7 General Assembly shall fund and distribute in an equitable 8 manner to the school districts the state's share of the cost 9 of the basic elementary and secondary school system. 10 Sec. 2. REFERRAL AND PUBLICATION. The foregoing proposed ll amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa is referred 12 to the General Assembly to be chosen at the next general 13 election for members of the General Assembly, and the 14 Secretary of State is directed to cause the same to be 15 published for three consecutive months previous to the date of 16 that election as provided by law. 17 EXPLANATION 18 This joint resolution proposes an amendment to the 19 Constitution of the State of Iowa relating to the 20 establishment of state responsibility to provide a basic 21 system of free quality public elementary and secondary 22 schools, with the state's share of the funding to be equitably 23 distributed.
