A Resolution to encourage the expansion of the
Iowa priority prescription savings program.

WHEREAS, the Iowa priority prescription savings
program was formed in July 2001 through an alliance of
consumers, pharmacists, physicians, and Medicare-
eligible individuals to provide safe, effective, and
affordable prescription drugs to Medicare-eligible
Iowans; and

WHEREAS, the Iowa priority prescription savings
program is offered through the not-for-profit Iowa
prescription drug corporation, which is located in
Iowa, thereby enabling easy access to members; and

WHEREAS, in addition to Medicare-eligible
individuals, many low-income parents lack prescription
drug coverage; and

WHEREAS, the framework of the Iowa priority
prescription savings program could be expanded to
include other groups; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, That the Iowa
prescription drug corporation is encouraged to expand
the Iowa priority prescription savings program to
include the parents of children who are participating
in the medical assistance or healthy and well kids in
Iowa program.
