

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 134

A Resolution honoring the Morningside College Women's Basketball Team on their national championship.

WHEREAS, Morningside College of Sioux City used a record setting three-point shooting display to win its first-ever women's basketball national championship when it defeated Cedarville University 87-74 in the title game of the NAIA Division II National Tournament in Sioux City's Tyson Events Center/Gateway Arena; and

WHEREAS, the Morningside Mustangs made a national tournament single-game record 17 three-point field goals to erase the former record of 15 three-pointers the Mustangs made in their opening round win; and

WHEREAS, Morningside shot a sizzling 48.6 percent from beyond the three-point arc with 17 treys in 35 attempts; and

WHEREAS, Morningside had 47 three-point field goals in its five national tournament games to also set a record; and

WHEREAS, Megan Cloud led the way by bombing in eight of 11 three-point shots to tie the national tournament single-game record, finished with 34 points to go along with six assists and six rebounds, and was named the tournament's Most Valuable Player; and

WHEREAS, Megan Cloud was joined on the all-tournament team by teammates Brittany Carper and Kate Lokken; and

WHEREAS, Morningside finished its storybook season with a 34-4 record to set a school record for
