

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 146

BY BLACK and IVERSON

1 A Resolution expressing the State of Iowa's appreciation
2 of its strong relations with the Republic of China
3 on Taiwan.

4 WHEREAS, the State of Iowa and several cities in
5 Iowa have established formal sister state and sister
6 city relationships with regions and cities in the
7 Republic of China on Taiwan; and

8 WHEREAS, the State of Iowa, one of the leading
9 agricultural-producing areas of the world, has
10 developed strong economic ties with the Republic of
11 China on Taiwan, which includes a dynamic trade
12 partnership with Iowa commodity organizations and
13 producers of the highest quality agricultural products
14 including beef, pork, corn, and soybeans; and

15 WHEREAS, the State of Iowa extends friendship and
16 goodwill to the people of the Republic of China on
17 Taiwan and expresses confidence that these two areas
18 of the world will prosper from this partnership; NOW
19 THEREFORE,

20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, That the Iowa Senate
21 declares the State of Iowa's appreciation for its
22 strong relations with the Republic of China on Taiwan,
23 and with the honorable Thomas T. S. Cheng, Director
24 General, Taipei Economic and Cultural Office, Chicago,
