7 heart" and home to former State Representative Ingwer  
8 Hansen who served in the Iowa House of Representatives  
9 from 1973 to 1982; and

12 ratio and a variety of extracurricular activities; and

13 WHEREAS, the city of Hartley proudly owns and  
14 operates its own electric, gas, and water utilities,
