12 WHEREAS, Iowa State University (ISU) Extension  
13 began at the request of the people of Iowa, when in  
14 1903, Sioux County farmers from Hull, Iowa, cooperated  
15 with the university to bring the land-grant college's  
16 programs and services to the people of this state; and  
17 WHEREAS, ISU Extension became the model for  
18 cooperative extension work that was adopted nationwide  
19 in 1914 with the passing of the federal Smith-Lever  
20 Act; and  
21 WHEREAS, ISU Extension partners with Iowans,  
22 including 900 locally elected Extension Council  
23 members, to provide research-based learning  
24 opportunities to improve quality of life in Iowa; and  
25 WHEREAS, ISU Extension embraces the university's  
26 strategic goals of learning, discovery, and  
27 engagement, and, through an active partnership and  
28 presence in every county, provides Iowans with access  
29 to the resources of the university and communicates  
30 the priorities of the citizens to the university; and

1 WHEREAS, in 2002, more than 665,000 clients had  
 2 individual contact with extension programs, the  
 3 extension distributed more than two million  
 4 publications in hard copy and three million copies  
 5 digitally, and extension information was accessed from  
 6 extension web sites approximately 20 million times,  
 7 evidence that ISU Extension is well-positioned to  
 8 support the growth and development of Iowa in the  
 9 knowledge-based economy and society of the 21st  
 10 century; and

11 WHEREAS, for the past 100 years, Iowa State  
 12 University has been helping Iowans become their best  
 13 and is ready and anxious to begin its next 100 years  
 14 of service to the state; NOW THEREFORE,

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, That the Senate  
 16 honors Iowa State University Extension for 100 years  
 17 of cooperative services and programs to Iowa and joins  
 18 in celebrating April 7, 2003, as the kickoff date for  
 19 Iowa State University Extension's inaugural  
 20 celebration of its creation 100 years ago.
