13 that the University of Iowa Hawkeyes Football Team
14 finished its regular season as cochampions of the Big
15 Ten Conference and participated in the Orange Bowl of
16 the Bowl Championship Series; and

17 WHEREAS, the Iowa Football Team finished its season
18 with a record of 11 wins and two losses and a perfect
19 eight wins and zero losses in the Big Ten Conference;

22 record 11 different players on the two First Team All-

14 that the University of Iowa Football Team deserves
15 recognition for all of its accomplishments during the
