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	Section 1. Section 149.5, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2003, is amended to read as follows:  A license to practice podiatry shall not authorize the licensee to amputate the human foot or use any general anesthetics other than local.  EXPLANATION  This bill provides for a change in language contained in Code section 149.5 regarding the administration of anesthetic by a podiatrist. Currently, Code section 149.5 provides that a podiatrist shall not be authorized to utilize any anesthetics other than local anesthetics. In response to som ambiguity regarding the scope of the term "local" anesthetics the bill changes the way the provision is phrased, to clarify that a podiatrist is not authorized to administer general anesthetics.
