- 3 707.5 INVOLUNTARY MANSLAUGHTER.
- 4 l. A person commits a class "C" felony when the person
- 5 unintentionally causes the death of another person under
- 6 circumstances manifesting an extreme indifference to the value
- 7 of human life.
- 8 1. 2. A person commits a class "D" felony when the person
- 9 unintentionally causes the death of another person by the
- 10 commission of a public offense other than a forcible felony or
- 11 escape.
- 12 2. 3. A person commits an aggravated misdemeanor when the
- 13 person unintentionally causes the death of another person by
- 14 the commission of an act in a manner likely to cause death or

- 20 This bill expands the definition of the criminal offense of

- 22 A person commits a class "C" felony under the bill if the
- 23 person unintentionally causes the death of another by the
- 24 commission of an act that manifests an extreme indifference to
- 25 the value of human life.
- A class "C" felony is punishable by confinement for no more
- 27 than 10 years and a fine of at least \$1,000 but not more than
- 28 \$10,000.
