1 Section 1. Section 99D.5, Code Supplement 2005, is amended 2 by adding the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 7. A member of the commission shall 4 comply with requirements made applicable to members pursuant 5 to Code chapter 99G.

Sec. 2. Section 99G.8, Code 2005, is amended by striking 6 7 the section and inserting in lieu thereof the following: 99G.8 BOARD OF DIRECTORS. 8

The authority shall be administered by a board of 9 1. 10 directors which shall be the state racing and gaming 11 commission created under section 99D.5.

12 2. Board members shall not have any direct or indirect 13 interest in an undertaking that puts their personal interest 14 in conflict with that of the authority, including but not 15 limited to an interest in a major procurement contract or a 16 participating retailer.

17 3. The board of directors may delegate to the chief 18 executive officer of the authority such powers and duties as 19 it may deem proper to the extent such delegation is not 20 inconsistent with the Constitution of this state. 21 EXPLANATION

22 This bill provides that the racing and gaming commission 23 shall be the board of directors of the Iowa lottery authority. 24 Under current law, a separate Iowa lottery authority board of 25 directors exists and that board is eliminated by the bill. 26 The current duties and requirements of the Iowa lottery 27 authority board are made the responsibility of the racing and 28 gaming commission by the bill.
