- 1 Section 1. Section 99B.10, Code Supplement 2005, is
- 2 amended by adding the following new subsection:
- NEW SUBSECTION. 10. An electrical or mechanical amusement
- 4 device required to be registered as provided by this section
- 5 shall not be located in any county in which the result of the
- 6 most recent referendum conducted in that county pursuant to
- 7 section 99F.7 was a defeat of a proposal to conduct gambling
- 8 games on excursion gambling boats or the defeat of a proposal
- 9 to conduct gambling games at a licensed pari-mutuel racetrack
- 10 enclosure.
- 11 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 99G.30A MONITOR VENDING MACHINES --
- 12 PROHIBITED AREAS.
- 13 1. A monitor vending machine shall not be located in any
- 14 county in which the result of the most recent referendum
- 15 conducted in that county pursuant to section 99F.7 was a
- 16 defeat of a proposal to conduct gambling games on excursion
- 17 gambling boats or the defeat of a proposal to conduct gambling
- 18 games at a licensed pari-mutuel racetrack enclosure.
- 19 2. For purposes of this section, a "monitor vending
- 20 machine" means a machine or other similar electronic device
- 21 that includes a video monitor and audio capabilities that
- 22 dispenses to a purchaser lottery tickets that have been
- 23 determined to be winning or losing tickets by a predetermined
- 24 pool drawing machine prior to the dispensing of the tickets.
- 25 EXPLANATION
- 26 This bill prohibits locating an electrical or mechanical
- 27 amusement device that is required to be registered or a
- 28 monitor vending machine of the Iowa lottery in any county that
- 29 has rejected a proposal to authorize gambling games on
- 30 excursion gambling boats or pari-mutuel racetracks. The bill
- 31 provides that the prohibition would not apply if the county
- 32 subsequently passes a referendum authorizing gambling games in
- 33 that county. The bill also defines a "monitor vending
- 34 machine" as a machine with a video monitor and audio
- 35 capabilities that dispenses to a purchaser lottery tickets
