1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 305.17 DESTRUCTION OF RECORDS -- 2 PENALTY.

3 The disposal and destruction of the records of an agency

4 shall be conducted in a manner to ensure the information

5 contained in such records is safeguarded against unauthorized

6 access, use, or disclosure. Paper records containing

7 identification information as defined in section 715A.8 shall

8 be destroyed by an employee of the state using a shredding

9 machine. A person who violates this section is guilty of a

10 simple misdemeanor.

## 11 EXPLANATION

12 This bill relates to the destruction of state agency

13 records. The bill requires the disposal and destruction of

14 state agency records to be conducted in a manner to ensure

15 that the information contained in the records is protected

16 from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure. If the record

17 is a paper record and contains identifying information, then

18 the record must be shredded by a state employee. Identifying

19 information is defined in Code section 715A.8 and includes a

20 person's name, address, date of birth, telephone number,

21 driver's license number, social security number, student

22 identification number, military identification number, savings

23 or checking account number, credit card number, and other

24 personal information.

25 The bill provides that a person who fails to destroy state

26 agency records in a manner to protect from unauthorized

27 disclosure or who fails to destroy paper agency records that

28 contain identifying information in a manner required by the

29 bill is guilty of a simple misdemeanor. A simple misdemeanor

30 is punishable by confinement for no more than 30 days or a

31 fine of at least \$50 but not more than \$500 or by both.
