A BILL FOR

An Act relating to adoption and termination of jurisdiction of a
court involving prior child support and custody proceedings.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 600B.31A TERMINATION OF - 2 JURISDICTION OF COURT ISSUING ORIGINAL ORDER.

If a proceeding is initiated in a court for an adoption 4 involving the children of parents whose paternity, obligation 5 for support, or custody determination has been determined 6 under this chapter or for modification of a child support or 7 custody order granted under this chapter, the following 8 requirements shall be met if the proceedings are initiated in 9 a court other than the court which issued the original order: 10 1. The party initiating the proceedings shall present to 11 the court the names and addresses of the parties to the 12 original proceeding, if known, as well as the name and place 13 of the court which issued the original order.

15 2. The court in which the proceedings are initiated shall 16 cause notice of the proceedings to be served upon all the 17 parties to the original order unless the parties are deceased. 18 The court in which the proceedings are initiated or any 19 party to the proceedings may also request that a copy of the 20 transcript of the proceedings of the court which issued the 21 original order be made available for consideration in the new 22 proceedings.

EXPLANATION

This bill provides requirements for certain actions under the paternity and obligation for support chapter, Code chapter 600B, that are initiated in a court other than the court which rissued the original order for paternity, child support, or child custody. In a proceeding for adoption involving the phildren of parents whose paternity, obligation for support, or custody determination was determined under Code chapter for adoption of a child support or custody order granted under Code chapter 600B, the party initiating the proceedings is required to present to the court the names and addresses of the parties to the original proceeding, if known, sa well as the name and place of the court which issued the

1 original order and the date of the original order. 2 Additionally, the court in which the proceedings are initiated 3 is required to cause notice of the proceedings to be served 4 upon the parties to the original order unless the parties are 5 deceased. The court in which the proceedings are initiated or 6 any party to the proceedings may also request that a copy of 7 the transcript of the proceedings of the court which issued 8 the original order be made available for consideration in the 9 new proceedings.
