Description

House File 2397 relates to assaults on employees of county jails or State Department of Corrections (DOC) facilities. The Bill adds saliva to the list of body fluids that cause an assault. Conviction of such assault is punished as a Class D felony.

Background

- 1. There were two convictions in the last three years under Section 708.3B, <u>Code of Iowa</u>. One conviction was for assault, and one conviction was for assault with body fluids.
- 2. The average State costs for one Class D felony conviction ranges from \$3,100 (court costs, probation, and indigent defense) to \$12,100 (court costs, jury trial, indigent defense, prison and parole). The maximum costs will be incurred across multiple years while the offender is supervised in the correctional system, either in prison or in the community.

Assumption

Charge, conviction, and sentencing patterns and trends will not change over the projection period.

Correctional Impact

Adding saliva to the list of body fluids that cause an assault may increase the number of Class D felony convictions. That increase cannot be estimated but is not anticipated to be significant.

Fiscal Impact

The fiscal impact of HF 2397 cannot be determined due to insufficient information. The State's cost for one new Class D felony conviction ranges from \$3,100 to \$12,100.
