4 not available or other existing conditions warrant it, 5 arrangements may be made for use of common carriers to 6 transport children who are ten years of age or older according 7 to uniform standards established by the director of the 8 department of education and at a cost based upon the actual 9 cost of service and approved by the board.

## EXPLANATION

11 This bill amends a provision that currently allows school 12 districts to arrange for the transportation of pupils by 13 common carrier rather than by school bus in situations that 14 warrant the substitution. Under the bill, children under 10 15 years of age could not be transported by common carrier. 16
