Section 1. STATE BOARD OF REGENTS -- ARTICULATION WEBSITE -- APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the state board of regents for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007, the following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purposes designated:

7 For the development, maintenance, and promotion of a credit 8 transfer and articulation internet website for use by students 9 who wish to transfer credits earned at a community college to 10 a state university governed by the board:

11 \$ 250,000

12 The general assembly finds that as college costs increase, 13 Iowa's community college students need access to resources 14 that allow the students to make informed, cost-effective 15 decisions regarding their postsecondary education plans. It 16 is the intent of the general assembly to provide for a 17 seamless transition for the students from Iowa's community 18 colleges to Iowa's state universities. Therefore, the state 19 board of regents shall, in cooperation with the department of 20 education and the community colleges, develop, maintain, and 21 promote a user-friendly credit transfer and articulation 22 internet website that allows Iowans to know at the time of 23 enrollment in a community college course whether the credit 24 will be accepted by the state university of the student's 25 choice, the category in which the university will apply the 26 credit, and to which degree program or programs the credit 27 will be applied by the university. The board and the 28 community colleges shall continuously strive to improve upon 29 the coordinating efforts between the state universities and 30 the community colleges to map and articulate community college 31 courses for college credit with the degree programs offered at 32 the state universities. The website shall be operational not 33 later than July 1, 2007.

This bill appropriates \$250,000 from the general fund of

1 the state to the state board of regents for the development, 2 maintenance, and promotion of a user-friendly credit transfer 3 and articulation internet website that allows Iowans to know 4 at the time of enrollment in a community college course 5 whether the credit earned will be accepted by the state 6 university of the student's choice, the category in which the 7 university will apply the credit, and to which degree program 8 or programs the credit will be applied by the university. The 9 website must be operational not later than July 1, 2007.
