### A BILL FOR

1 An Act modifying provisions relating to utilization of indirect  
2 cost reimbursements in appropriations to the office of grants  
3 enterprise management of the department of management, and  
4 making an appropriation.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 8A.505, subsection 2, Code 2005, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 2. There is appropriated annually from ~~the-increase-in~~  
4 indirect cost reimbursements ~~over-the-amount-of-indirect-cost~~  
5 ~~reimbursements-received-during-the-fiscal-year-beginning-July~~  
6 ~~17-2002~~, to the office of grants enterprise management of the  
7 department of management the sum of up to one hundred twenty-  
8 five thousand dollars for the expenses of the office, and  
9 annually for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 2006, and  
10 ending June 30, 2008, the sum of thirty-five thousand dollars  
11 to provide grant identification and writing assistance to  
12 state agencies. The director shall transfer the funds  
13 appropriated to the department of management as provided in  
14 this subsection and shall make the funds ~~resulting-from-the~~  
15 ~~increase-in-reimbursements~~ available during the fiscal year to  
16 the department of management on a monthly basis. ~~If-the~~  
17 ~~amount-of-the-increase-in-indirect-cost-reimbursements-is~~  
18 ~~insufficient-to-pay-the-maximum-appropriation-provided-for-in~~  
19 ~~this-subsection, the-amount-appropriated-is-equal-to-the~~  
20 ~~amount-of-such-increase.~~

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#### EXPLANATION

22 This bill deletes a provision that appropriations to the  
23 office of grants enterprise management of the department of  
24 management from indirect cost reimbursements to state agencies  
25 shall only be taken from the increase in indirect cost  
26 reimbursements over the amount of indirect cost reimbursements  
27 received during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002.  
28 Instead, the bill provides that the appropriations will be  
29 taken from indirect cost reimbursements without qualification  
30 relating to increases over the 2002 level. The bill also  
31 provides that the current annual appropriation of up to  
32 \$125,000 shall be allocated for office expenses, and that an  
33 additional appropriation for FY 2006-2007 and FY 2007-2008 of  
34 \$35,000 each year shall be made to provide grant  
35 identification and writing assistance to state agencies. The

1 bill makes corresponding changes and deletions to remaining  
2 language in the applicable subsection.
