1 Amend House File 2566 as follows:
2 1. Page 1, by inserting after line 6 the
3 following:
4 "Sec. ____ . STATE JUVENILE INSTITUTIONS --
5 POPULATION STUDY. An analysis of the juveniles placed
6 at the Iowa juvenile home and the state training
7 school shall be conducted by the division of criminal
8 and juvenile justice planning of the department of
9 human rights with the cooperation and assistance of
10 the department of human services. The analysis shall
11 address the backgrounds, demographic aspects, and
12 factors involved with the placement of children at the
13 institutions over a period of time identified in the
14 analysis. The purpose of the analysis is to identify
15 any trends or patterns that exist in the children's
16 admissions, referrals, treatment received, outcomes,
17 or behaviors exhibited by the children upon departure
18 from an institution. The division shall provide an
19 initial report on the analysis during the fiscal year
20 beginning July 1, 2006, progress updates, and a final
21 report when the analysis is completed."

1 Section 1. Section 232.52, subsection 2, paragraph e,
2 subparagraph (2), Code Supplement 2005, is amended to read as
3 follows:

4 (2) The child has committed an act ~~which-is-a-crime~~
5 ~~against-a-person-and~~ which would be an aggravated misdemeanor
6 or a felony if the act were committed by an adult.

7 EXPLANATION

8 This bill relates to placement of a juvenile in the state
9 training school or other facility.

10 The bill strikes language relating to a juvenile's
11 commission of a crime against a person that is an aggravated
12 misdemeanor or felony as one of the conditions that would
13 allow a court to order placement in the state training school.
14 The bill provides that a juvenile only commit a crime that is
15 an aggravated misdemeanor or felony as a condition for
16 placement in the state training school. The bill does not
17 change any of the other conditions that make a juvenile
18 eligible for the state training school.

19 Under the bill, a juvenile becomes eligible for placement
20 at the state training school or any other facility if the
21 court finds any three of the following conditions exist: (1)
22 the child is at least 15 years of age and the court finds the
23 placement to be in the best interests of the child or the
24 public; (2) the child has committed an act that would be an
25 aggravated misdemeanor or a felony if committed by an adult;
26 (3) the child has previously been found to have committed a
27 delinquent act; or (4) the child has previously been placed in
28 a treatment facility outside the child's home or in a
29 supervised treatment facility.
