1 Section 1. Section 692A.4A, Code Supplement 2005, is  
2 amended by striking the section and inserting in lieu thereof  
3 the following:

4 692A.4A ELECTRONIC MONITORING.

5 The department of corrections shall adopt by rule pursuant  
6 to chapter 17A a program establishing an electronic monitoring  
7 system to monitor the location and movements of a person  
8 required to register under this chapter. Public safety shall  
9 be the overriding criterion of any electronic monitoring  
10 program established pursuant to this section.

11 EXPLANATION

12 This bill relates to persons required to register as sex  
13 offenders.

14 The bill requires the department of corrections to adopt  
15 rules to establish a program for an electronic monitoring  
16 system to monitor the location and movements of a registered  
17 sex offender. The bill requires that public safety be the  
18 overriding factor when establishing such a program. Current  
19 law provides that if a person required to register as a sex  
20 offender committed an offense involving a minor, the person  
21 shall be supervised for a period of at least five years by an  
22 electronic tracking an monitoring system.
